As per the G.O.(Ms.) No. 100, issued by Health & Family Welfare
Department, Chennai dated 14.5.2003, the eligibility criteria for admission to
MBBS degree course is as follows:-

Eligibility Criteria

- (a) **O.C.**: Minimum of 60% of marks in Biology or Botany &
Zoology taken together. 60% of marks in each
subject viz.,Physics and Chemistry. Aggregate
should not be less than 140 out of 200.
- (b) **B.C.**: Minimum of 60% of marks in Biology or Botany &
Zoology taken together. 60% of marks in each
subject viz.,Physics and Chemistry. Aggregate
should not be less than 130 out of 200.
- (c) **M.B.C.**: Minimum of 55% of marks in Biology or Botany &
Zoology taken together. 55% of marks in each
subject viz.,Physics and Chemistry. Aggregate
should not be less than 120 out of 200.
- (d) **SC/ST**: Minimum of 40% of marks in Biology or Botany &
Zoology taken together. 40% of marks in each
subject viz., Physics and Chemistry. Aggregate
should not be less than 80 out of 200.

An Agenda was placed before the Special Meeting of the Governing Council held on 12.5.2011 to decide on further course of action for Registering the candidates for the academic year 2010-11 in respect of Private Medical Colleges.

The Governing Council have examined the above matter and resolved among others:-

To accept and recommend the following proposal for eligibility of marks for admission into Medical colleges that are affiliated to this University.

a) Admission by Single Window System – As per G.O. Ms: No.100.

(Selection by the Selection Committee
Directorate of Medical Education)


b) Admission under Management quota done
by the respective Managements – As per MCI Guidelines.

In order to avoid the disparity in eligibility of marks for admission of students in Medical course, an agenda was placed before the 211th Meeting of the Governing Council, held on 25.4.2012 again, in which it was resolved to re-fix the eligibility marks for admission to the MBBS course as per the G.O.Ms.No.100, Health & Family Welfare department dated 14.5.2003.

Therefore, as per the resolution passed by the Meeting of the Governing Council of this University, it has been decided to follow the eligibility marks prescribed in G.O. (Ms.)No.100, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 14.5.2003 from the academic year 2012-13 onwards for admission under Management quota done by the respective managements.
