WELCOME TO DHANALAKSHMI SRINIVASAN MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL

Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Medical College And Hospital is a state of the art medical school, situated across sprawling 100 acres of land located at the national high way (NH45 Trichy – Chennai high way) at Siruvachur, Perambalur District, with a buildup area of 12 lakhs square feet. We provide charity medical services to the rural population in and around major districts like Athur, Kallakurichi, Ariyalur, and Cuddalore and up to the Salem under the aegis of Srinivasan Charitable & Educational Trust which has been in the field of education and for more than two decades.

The Srinivasan Charitable & Educational Trust wanted to improve the life of Rural and Backward population of Perambalur and Adjoining Districts. The Trustee and Trust members of Srinivasan Charitable & Educational trust felt that by giving medical education and Health care service brought together results drastic changes to society for the budding life of younger generation.

The General public in and round of Perambalur and adjacent district was throng to Pondicherry, Chennai and Madurai to get Quality medical care services, which very far from Perambalur district. Even there are no hospital having more than 50 beds, which is not feasible to provide proper patient care, Inpatient services and surgical facilities other than Government hospital. To receive Secondary care and Tertiary care treatment, the public residing in Perambalur and surround areas has to approach other district medical college hospitals which were located at Villupuram, Salem and Tiruchirapalli.

Perambalur and adjoining districts did not have Medical College or well equipped hospital to serve the poor people except Government Hospitals at Perambalur, Ariyalur and Cuddalore. This area is prevalent for Renal Diseases and other Communicable Diseases. Those who are suffering from dread full acute illness like Heart Attack, Stroke, Renal Failure and Liver Failure, Cancer, and Road Traffic Accident victims have to go to Trichy, Villupuram, Chennai, Pondicherry or Chennai for higher treatment. The rural population of Perambalur and adjoining districts were very poor because of lack of industries and frequent monsoon failures. By considering the above conditions, the Trust initially felt to have a well equipped Medical College & hospital at Perambalur, so that, it can serve the poor rural population as well as bring up young talented doctors to the society.

The Medical Council of India has given the Letter of Permission for 150 M.B.B.S. annual admissions during the year 2011. Our hospital functions with 1300 beds which include 1210 teaching beds , 157 Intensive Care Beds and 140 accessory beds. We are equipped with 18 Hi-Fi modular theatres, 6 minor operation theatres, 157 bedded ICU of various specialties, 24/7 functioning blood bank with component separation facility, accident and emergency critical care, well equipped central clinical lab fortified with other departments of General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopedics, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, Chest & TB, Skin & VD, ENT, Psychiatry and Dentistry. The Hospital had an average 2400 to 2500 outpatient

turnout per day, records bed occupancy rate more than 80% and performing 50000 plus surgical procedures per year. Round about 405 plus dedicated doctors, 780 nursing and paramedical staff, and 600 other ancillary staffs are rendering their services for improving the health care of the general public.

In a short span of few years this hospital has started its Super Speciality services like Dialysis, Renal transplantation, Liver Transplantation, Heart Transplantation, Nuerology, Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, Gastroenterology, Urology along with other Interventional & Cardiac Surgical Procedures.

In order to meet the shortfall specialists, the Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Medical college and Hospital, has applied various Post Graduate Medical Degree courses and Super Specialty degree courses in all the Pre, Para Clinical and Super Specialty departments .Meanwhile we have obtained the Letter of Permission for 74 seats in various Post Graduate courses, in few of them got Recognition status by the then MCI/NMC.
